- Corno in Fa:** Plays a sustained chord starting with a forte (*f*) dynamic. In the second section, it plays a sustained chord with a pianissimo (*pp*) dynamic.
- Tromba in Sib:** Plays a sustained chord starting with a forte (*f*) dynamic. In the second section, it remains silent.
- Trombone:** Plays a sustained chord starting with a forte (*f*) dynamic. In the second section, it plays a sustained chord with a pianissimo (*pp*) dynamic.
- Euphonium:** Plays a melodic line starting with a forte (*f*) dynamic.
- Tuba:** Remains silent in the first section. In the second section, it plays a melodic line with a mezzo-piano (*mp*) dynamic.
- Tamburo:** Plays a rhythmic pattern starting with a mezzo-forte (*mf*) dynamic.
- Grancassa:** Plays a rhythmic pattern starting with a forte (*f*) dynamic.
